During the period from the 6th to the 3rd century B.C. a people called the Celts spread across Europe from the east to the west. More than one Celtic tribe invaded Britain. From time to time these tribes were attacked and overcome by other Celtic tribes from the Continent. The Celts did not write down the events themselves. Other peoples who knew them described them in their books. The Greeks were the first to mention the British Isles. It is from the Greek books that we know about the Phoenicians, who were great sailors and traders even before the Greeks and who travelled as far as the shores of Britain. The military leaders of the largest tribes were sometimes called kings and stood at the head of detachments of warriors. The Celts had no towns; they lived in villages. Being a parent is one of the most challenging tasks in the world. Parents ought to love, protect and guide their child. They should show affection and sympathy, understand their children's feelings and help them solve their problems. It doesn't require a great share of discipline on the part of the parent and that of the child. There are no clear conduct patterns or strict demands as sometimes parents fear to lose their children's love if they set limits. Children are usually given unrestricted freedom and they are allowed to behave as they want and to do what they wish. Children are given enough freedom but at the same time they are under their parents' constant control. The main goal is building strong trusting relationships between parents and children. Germany and the other defeated powers, Austria-Hungary, Bulgaria and Turkey, were not represented at the conference; nor was Russia, which had fought as one of the Allied powers until 1917, when the country's new Bolshevik government concluded a separate peace with Germany and withdrew from the conflict. The Big Four themselves had competing objectives in Paris: Clemenceau's main goal was to protect France from yet another attack by Germany. In the years following the Treaty of Versailles, many ordinary Germans believed they had been betrayed by the "November Criminals," those leaders who signed the treaty and formed the post-war government.
