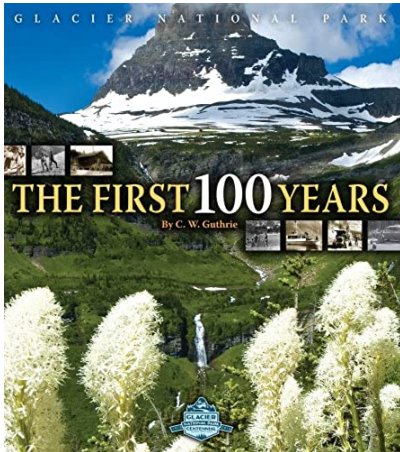

While the park is still home to more than a dozen glaciers, even more impressive are the massive U-shaped valleys and hulking granite peaks carved by long-ago ice flows. Fast facts. Established: 1910. 100 years of service. Roe Emery (1875-1953) was one of two principals behind the creation of Glacier's iconic Red Buses. Emery and Walter White, a vice president of the Cleveland-based White Motor Company, which built the Red Buses, introduced transportation to the park in 1914. Many in the current fleet of Red Buses have been in service since the mid-1930s. The Red Buses were the first authorized motor transportation utility in any National Park. In 1936, with park reservations up more than 70 percent above 1935 levels, 18 new buses joined the fleet. The purchase was made from the White Motor Glacier National Park's 100th anniversary lured more than 2 million visitors last year, a record for the park. As the 10th national park established in the United States, Glacier National Park, in Montana, celebrated its 100th anniversary on May 11, 2010. During the first 11 months of the year, some 2,216,109 visitors came to the park, breaking the record of 2,203,847 set in 1983, the Associated Press reported.
