Why Are We Here? is the first episode of the machinima series Red vs. Blue, and premiered on the Rooster Teeth website on April 1, 2003. It introduces the characters of Simmons, Grif, Sarge, Church, and Tucker in a boxed canyon known as "Blood Gulch". Simmons: Seriously though, why are we out here?
