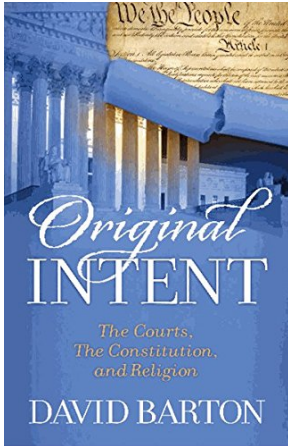

The modern Court largely amassed its control over religion first by discarding the traditional limitations of the religion clauses of the First Amendment, and then by adopting the phrase "separation of church and state" as the modern measuring stick for judging the propriety of a challenged religious expression. Original intent refers to the notion that the judiciary should interpret the Constitution (including the First Amendment) in accordance with the understanding of its framers.
The courts' commitment to original intent is somewhat tested, however, by the reality that the framers' intentions are not always easy to identify. Madison believed constitutional interpretation should rest on the intentions of the people who ratified the Constitution. Another factor is that it has never been clear to what extent the framers' intentions are relevant to the task of establishing constitutional norms. Some even disagreed on this point.
