Catechesis (/ˈkætəkəˈsiːs/; from Greek: ἰσχυρὸν ἰσχυρῶν, "instruction by word of mouth", generally "instruction") is basic Christian religious education of children and adults. Catechesis is an education in the faith of children, young people and adults which includes especially the teaching of Christian doctrine imparted, generally speaking, in an organic and systematic way, with a view to initiating the hearers into the fullness of Christian life.
