


Biblia Hebraica Stuttgartensia: A Reader's Edition

The BHS Reader's Edition is for those who have a basic understanding of Biblical Hebrew and desire to read and study the Hebrew Bible. With this book alone, students are able to read the Hebrew Bible in its entirety. Main features include: Complete text of the Biblia Hebraica Stuttgartensia, checked against the Leningrad Codex; All words that occur fewer than 70 times are parsed and contextually defined in the apparatus; Glossary listing of all other words; Improved layout of poetic texts; All weak verb forms are parsed; High quality paper does not bleed through. From the Introduction: Vocabulary, however, is not the only obstacle in the way of potential readers. In spite of their hard work in learning the paradigms, the weak roots still seem impenetrable. Even strong verbs, if they have pronominal suffixes, are sometimes beyond decipherment. Nouns, too, if not already known, can be difficult to figure out if they have a pronominal suffix. The result of this situation is that most students quit trying to read their Hebrew Bibles. Consequently, they lose whatever grasp they had of the language except, maybe, for the ability to look up a Hebrew word in a lexicon. Many students opt not to preach or teach from the Hebrew, opting instead for an English translation. All that hard work spent in learning the language is seemingly wasted. Again, it is reading—and lots of it—that solves this problem.

It is the fourth edition in the Biblia Hebraica series started by Rudolf Kittel and is published by the Deutsche Bibelgesellschaft (German Bible Society) in Stuttgart.
